### **Urban Regeneration: CNAPP, “New Paradigms of Urban Living: Proximity and Well-being in Cities and Territories” International Conference on March 24<sup>th</sup> in Rome, at the Palazzo Rospigliosi Conference Centre.**

Rome, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Representatives of Italian and European institutions, academics, experts, and professionals will gather **on March 24<sup>th</sup> in Rome** to explore how our cities are evolving and to identify the new paradigms that will shape urban life in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

The “*New Paradigms of Urban Living: Proximity and Well-being in Cities and Territories*” international conference, will be the final step of a series of events entitled “*Italy in Proximity*”, that the **National Council of Architects, Planners, Landscapers and Conservationists (CNAPP)** has organized. This initiative forms part of a strategic effort carried out in collaboration with its **Scientific Committee**, chaired by **Carlos Moreno**, author of the “15-minute city” concept, in support of the **Urban Regeneration Bill** currently under consideration by the Parliament.

It is a law proposal that reflects a **renewed commitment to a more sustainable, inclusive, and proximity-based urban future**. The CNAPP has contributed to the bill through **proposals and recommendations emphasizing the value of time, proximity, and quality of life as key elements in urban and architectural transformations, including their impacts on the economy, mobility, and new ways of living**.

During the **six thematic sessions**, key challenges will be addressed, **including climate adaptation, the city of reclaimed time, the proximity economy, mobility, and the future of urban intelligence in the transformation of our territories**.
